## November, 2024 NCCC Governors' Meeting Recap

Following is a recap of the NCCC governors' meeting and the West Region meeting, held in St Louis on November 9, 2024. Complete minutes of those meetings can be found on the NCCC website and the West Region, NCCC website respectively.

<u>West Region meeting recap:</u> three \$500.00 scholarship award checks were disbursed. There was a lengthy discussion regarding the scholarship fund, awards, and funding. The newly revised WR operating rules and bylaws reflect changes made to the scholarship fund. The Regional Membership Director (Deb Hird) reported that there are 1,492 members in the WR and 16 active clubs.

A new methodology for performing post event inspections for C-8s will be tested at the 2025 convention drag race event.

The new WR by-lars and operating rules will do away with paper ballots and will require electronic voting in all future elections.

2025 Competition events: Cornhusker Corvette Club will host a 3-day Memorial weekend event, a 3-day, Labor Day event, and numerous 2-day weekend events throughout the summer months. Corvette Club of Iowa will host a 1 Or 2 day event in the May/June timeframe and a 2-day event in September.

WR officers for 2025 will be as follows: RE, Dennis Luther; RCD, Lauren Killum; RMD, Deb Hird; Secretary, Sheila Wyman; and Treasurer, Linda Hommer.

NCCC Governors' meeting recap: President Deb Murphy reported that there will be a new Director of Development hired very soon at the National Corvette Museum. Additionally, and new Director of Membership will also be hired at the National Corvette Museum. Finally, it is expected that the new CEO of the National Corvette Museum will be named for the National Corvette Museum by early 2025.

NCCC will begin accepting applications for scholarships in January, 2025.
